A. For OCEA members, our union is a family. And like any family, we value sharing meals together. Our mobile hot dog grill visits job sites throughout the County to cook up free lunch for employees. OCEA also uses the wagon to support important community activities that advance the interests of working families, such as feeding people on picket lines, charity events and at our annual health fair. The hot dog wagon supported Gov. Jerry Brown's campaign this year by feeding 100s of precinct walkers and attendees at a Labor Day rally, which kicked off Brown's campaign in Orange County.
